ORDINANCE NO. 2024-03 ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF KULPMONT, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-05, WHICH OUTLINES A QUALITY-OF-LIFE ORDINANCE AND VIOLATIONS TICKETING PROCESS

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Council of the Borough of Kulpmont, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, finding it to be the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the public and pursuant to the foregoing amendment to the property maintenance rules, regulations and procedures shall apply and ordain as follows:

SECTION 2. Section 3, Paragraph Number 13 shall be amended to read as follows: Storage Containers for Waste or Trash. The owner of every premise shall supply approved contained for trash/waste, as well as, be responsible for the removal of rubbish. All containers that store waste or trash shall be durable, watertight and made of metal or plastic. Containers must have tight-fitting covers and must be kept clean and odor free at all times. All containers must be stored at the **REAR** where possible of every property so said containers are not visible from the public right of way. All trash for pick up must be placed in the alley, if the property extends the entire lot. If the property does not extend the entire lot, waste/trash containers may only be placed in front of any property when darkness occurs the night before the day of the scheduled waste/trash pick-up day. Once the licensed hauler removes the waste/trash from any property, all containers must be returned to the rear of any property before daybreak on the day following pick up. (Example: Jim Smith=s trash collection day is Wednesday. He may place his trash containers out front of his property on Tuesday night, once night falls. He must place his trash container in the rear of his yard before daybreak on Thursday morning.)

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This ordinance shall take effect five days after its enactment and any prior ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Enacted and Ordained this 10th day of July, 2024.
